

<u>Sunset Gap</u> needs your help! Ten years ago a grant paid for a refrigerated truck for Sunset Gap, which allowed them to include fresh items in food boxes. Much of what they distribute comes from government programs as well as Second Harvest, FISH Hospitality Pantries, grocery stores, and other sources in and around Knoxville,

which is an hour away. Without refrigeration they can only pick up non-perishable food. Careful maintenance and periodic repairs kept their truck running until last winter, when it broke down on Interstate 40 on the way to pick up food. The verdict was dire: the truck needs a new engine. The cost? \$55,000. Without their refrigerated truck, they have been unable to pick up perishable items since December 2022. They are asking for donations on a GoFundMe page to help reach this important goal, so they can continue to feed hungry families.
